You are going to be given a lot of notes from your ensemble directors and from myself. Notes are things we want you to work on. You need to read them and think about them to apply them to your scene work, songs, choreography and music. Practicing at home is now vital so every time we come together at rehearsals we're getting better and better. If you aren't sure about what you have to work then contact your ensemble directors for guidance, they will be happy to know you're thinking about what you're doing.

The holidays will see our set constructed at St Pius, this will give you a massive boost but will also mean you have a new thing to think about in your performance so be completely across everything you have learnt so far. Ask questions about the set in the next couple of weeks if you're not sure about anything. It might be where tables are going to be placed or have I got a prop in this scene? There are mops and buckets and scrubbing brushes and ropes and lots of hand props that you can utilise when you go onstage if you wish. Take the initiative and use them! If you're unsure but want to use one then just talk to Pat and he'll organise for you, this goes for vocalists and dancers as well as actors - we are all characters in the story – whatever you think will help you!

Finally, as we go into these final weeks as well as working hard, listening to notes and keeping our energy up — enjoy every minute! It's an exciting time, make sure you relish it!
